

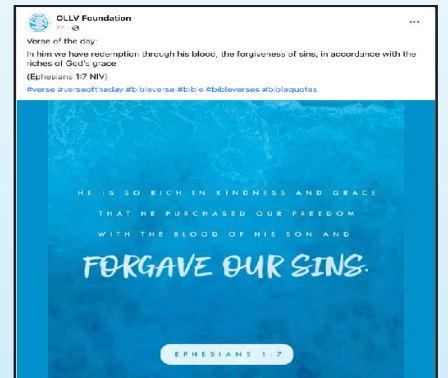

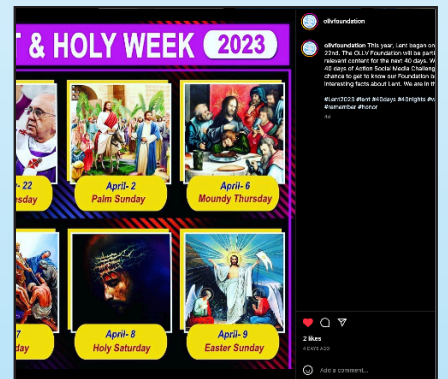

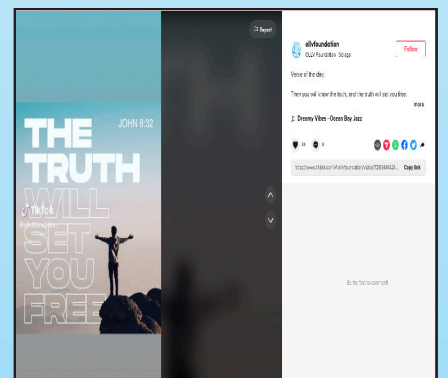

On October 18th, 2022, ground was broken at the Marian Court, Christ Cathedral campus, to initiate the launch of the Our Lady of La Vang Marian gardens project. The Our Lady of La Vang shrine was a major accomplishment for the campus, and its project management team and this was the day that marked the beginning of phase 2. The Marian gardens will delineate the life of Mary with interpretations of her life events. Additionally, it will hold prayer areas, walking tours, and a water feature in front of the shrine's martyr wall. This ground-breaking event also marks the insurrection of the OLLV Foundation.

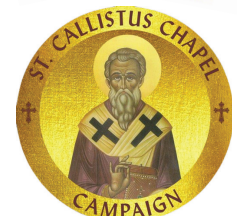

A Message From Our CEO

Dear Friends of the OLLV Foundation, I am blessed to announce the launch of the Our Lady of La Vang (OLLV) foundation newsletter. This newsletter is designed to provide you with information about who we are, what we do, and how you can get involved. We are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization located in the Diocese of Orange. Blessed by Bishop Kevin Vann, the OLLV Foundation was formed in 2022. Named after the Marian apparition that appeared to the persecuted Vietnamese Catholics in 1798, and the success of the Our Lady of La Vang shrine that was dedicated in 2021. The OLLV Foundation was tasked with the fundraising and project management of the new worship spaces located on the Christ Cathedral campus. The shrine and the Martyr Wall, to the right, are only phase one for the Foundation. Phase two for the shrine is a Marian Garden designed to let visitors pay homage to our Blessed Mother and experience inspiration through her 4 Marian mysteries. The OLLV Foundation was entrusted with the management of the second phase of the Christ Cathedral building. In the undercroft of the Cathedral, a 12,000 square foot space will be used to build a Chapel and Crypts with the name of St. Callistus. This pays tribute the old St. Callistus Parish that was asked to move when the Diocese of Orange purchased the Crystal Cathedral and renamed it the Christ Cathedral. The Crypts will be a resting place for our Bishops and the surrounding niches will be for our faithful.

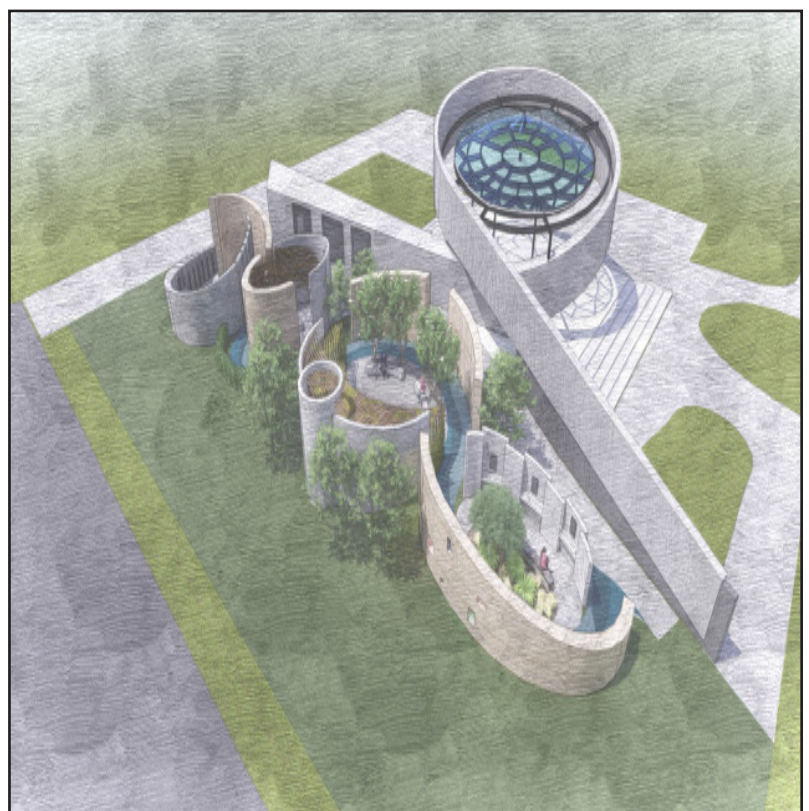
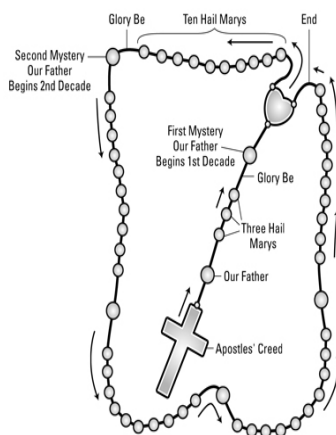

The 12,500 square foot space in the undercroft of the Christ Cathedral church is the new location for the St. Callistus Chapel and Crypts. The Chapel will allow seating for up to 250 parishioners for mass, weddings and funerals. The crypts will have eternal resting places for 40 bishops and 1,054 niches. The Chapel will house many unique sacred art items that are available for sponsorship. The Martyr Wall is attached to the alpha structure of the Our Lady of La Vang shrine. The wall includes the names and the cause of death for the 117 known saints that were martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. The wall represents the 96 Vietnamese, 11 Spaniards, and 10 French martyrs that were canonized on June 19, 1988 by John Paul II.
